

A completed Breeding Certificate must be submitted along with the registration application for any sheep being registered if the sire was not owned by the registration applicant (e.g., sire was borrowed or leased.) The Breeding Certificate must be signed by the owner of the sire to certify this ram bred the ewe (the dam of the sheep being registered) and that this ram is registered with SCHSIA and meets the SCHSIA breed standard.
