#### Fellow SCHSIA members,

As some of you know, I try to make it a habit of calling our new members to welcome them and obtain feedback on why they joined SCHSIA as well as how our Board can assist them. The feedback on their reasons for joining are usually the same- we want to maintain the "polled and white" breed standard that has been in effect for over 30 years and we want to belong to an association that is run by, and representative of, it's members. This is exactly our mission as expressed from day one on the home page of our website. It must be working because we now have 122 dues paying members including 26 new members in the first six months of 2015. Registrations are also up by 25% this year, over 400 in that same time period.

An important event taking place very soon is our **annual meeting and education day**, Friday and Saturday October 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>, in Oklahoma City. Rob and Joy Bass and Jason and Miranda Pelzel are hosting this exciting event which will include a Friday night dinner and Saturday luncheon included in the nominal registration fee of \$15 PP. # Pedigree Database A How-To Guide

Fellow Members, I've had several requests to publish some helpful hints for those of you, like me, who have not yet accepted the "computer age". Here we go:

First, go to our website by clicking on this link: <a href="www.stcroixhairsheep.org">www.stcroixhairsheep.org</a> or typing that into your browser. (You can also search Google for the term: SCHSIA.)

Once on the Home Page, move the cursor to the **Registration** page and then down to the bottom tab- "**Pedigrees**". Click on that tab.

Now you are on the Pedigrees home page, so either click on the "Sheep Search" tab or the link below in the first sentence which takes you to the "Sheep Search" Results page.

Next, click on the "Custom Search Results" link in the upper left hand corner to see the default settings of what items will be displayed and how many rows. The default settings are all items checked except owner and breeder state and 100 rows. You may change any of those as you see fit and click the "Submit" button at bottom. This will show all the sheep currently listed in the data base (3310 as of 8/5/15). You can also view all sheep by simply leaving all fields blank and clicking the search button whenever you are on the "Sheep Search Results" page. As each page contains 100 results, there are 34 pages. If you don't want to scroll through so many pages, you can set the "Custom Search Results" up to 1000 per page.

Now, in order to refine your search, lets say you want to search for sheep owners in KY. Simply click on the "Owner State" control, scroll to KY, click on KY and then click "search". This will list all sheep owned by Breeders in KY, 95 at this date. The default will be listing in order of registration dates with the newest listed first. You can sort by owner, breeder or any other column by simply clicking at top of that column. If you want to change that sort order, just click again to toggle between ascending and descending order.

Now, let's say you want to look at a particular owner's sheep. Since Keibler (Hemmer Hill Farm) are newest registrations, listed at top, click on their name and you will find a page that gives contact information, membership expiration date and the numbers of sheep owned and bred. By clicking on the "View List" tab next to either, you can view a complete list of those bred or owned. For example, using Hemmer Hill Farm, click the list of sheep owned and 41 will be listed, again with the latest registration first.

Now let's say you are looking for a Ram lamb and want to view the particular info about that animal. Click on the registration # 1227N at the top left of the page and you will see details about that ram lamb, including date of birth, tag #, sire, dam, and whether single, twin or triplet, Also, you can then click on the (I) information,(P) pedigree, or (O) offspring to see more detailed data on both the Sire and the Dam. For example, by clicking on the P button at the top of the page for 1227N, HHF 1514, you will see a 5 generation pedigree for that lamb. In addition, by moving the cursor to any of the sheep listed and clicking you will have the pedigree for any of those in the back line. Once on the pedigree page for that sheep, simply click on the I or O buttons for additional details about that animal. At any time, you can return to the pedigrees, sheep search, or SCHSIA home pages by clicking on one of the tabs at top of each page.

Summer is a busy time of year, so please don't forget about your SCHSIA dues. As of June 30<sup>th</sup>, there are 27 members out of the 122 listed on the web site whose dues for 2015 have not yet been paid. We realize that some of you have not registered sheep this year. However, according to our By Laws dues are payable each calendar year whether or not sheep are registered or transferred. If not paid by Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> each year then membership is considered terminated.

At the July meeting, the Board adopted a reinstatement fee of \$20, in addition to the annual dues for any member whose membership lapses and then later wants to register or transfer sheep. This was done to ensure that those members who pay their dues each year are not penalized for doing so.

Your Board of Directors encourages you to check on the web site by going to the member list and clicking on your name. Your dues expiration date will be shown along with other contact information.
